- b) Defibrillator at Albury Sports Club: the Club have raised funds to buy a defibrillator, which will be mounted at the Clubhouse. They have submitted a request to the Parish Council for a grant to purchase an outside cabinet, at a cost of £495.95 + vat.
- c) Development of Clubhouse: The Sports Club have asked for support with their planning applications. They have also requested a grant towards the storage building, cost in the region of £20,000, and suggest that, if the Parish Council could assist with this, part of the storage could be allocated for the storage of parish council equipment. The Sports Club are seeking grants from a number of other sources. The redevelopment of the clubhouse will cost iro £450,000 for the larger proposal and £250,000 for the smaller proposal.
